

-Stopped the Sun and moved the Earth gave birth to his tribe Polish


■ **He is one of the greatest astronomers in the history of the world. He proved that the Earth and planets revolve around a stationary Sun. At age 18, he enrolled at the Faculty of Liberal Arts at the Academy of Krakow, which was known as a center of study in mathematics, astronomy and the humanities.**



Maria Skłodowska - curie


- Polish Nobel laureate

- **She has built a device for measuring radioactivity and her husband discovered two radioactive elements - polonium and radium. For this achievement, in 1903 received the Nobel Prize in physics.**



Jan Matejko

- **He is the most distinguished Polish XIX century history painting. The most famous works of Jan Matejko: Stanczyk, Sermon complaints, the Union of Lublin, Stefan Batory at Pskov, Copernicus, the Batt of Grunwald, Prussian Homage, Sobieski at Vienna, Kosciuszko Raclawice.**



Fryderyk Chopin

- **He is the greatest Polish composer and pianist, and a leading representative of the Romantic period of music in the world. At the age of six years Frederick began playing the piano.**
- **The best-known pieces by Chopin are:**
 - **Piano Concerto in E minor**
 - **Rondo a la Krakowiak in F major**
 - **Waltz in E-flat major**
 - **Piano Concerto in F minor**
 - **Ballade in G minor**
 - **Mazurkas: G minor, C major, C minor,**
 - **Etude in F minor, C-sharp minor**
 - **Polonaise in C sharp minor, A major,**
 - **Preludes: E minor (suffocation), in B minor (Sound of Bells), A-flat major (Polish dancer), C minor (Funeral March)**
 - **Rollers: A flat major. A minor. F major**




Adam mickiewicz

- **He is considered one of the greatest Polish poets of the Romantic period. Mickiewicz In 1833 he went to Paris, where he married Celina Szymanowska, with whom he had six children.**

Lech Wałęsa
